

Betty Bird came to Australia in 1974 and was England's No 2 ranked female player in her youth. She came to WDTTC and played in pennant and tournament competition in S.A. but also entered in Word Championships in countries all over the world and brought home medals. When she was 83yrs she had the title of World Champion. Betty was a Club Committee member from 1998 to 2014 and is still showing endurance and skill on the table. She is remembered for looking out for bargains for the canteen in crisps and lollies. Betty has always played with pimple rubbers. She went to Bendigo in Oct 2018 for the Australian Vets and won gold in 80 WS – (5 years in a row) and gold in the 80 WD also Best player award in 80's plus No2 ranking in 75 WS in Aust. In the recent Veteran's tournament, she won the three events she went in. A true legend.

Club History

With the fortuitous discovery of some old club minutes and correspondence dated 1955-1971 tucked away in the bottom drawer of an old filing cabinet in the rear of the clubrooms, we are now able to provide some interesting excerpts of Club History over the ensuing months. For those members interested in financial trivia, a letter was sent by the Hon. Secretary of the WDTTC on the 25^{th} .May 1955 to the SATTA (now TTSA) enclosed with a cheque for £16/5/- for the purchase of one table tennis table. This amount equates to around \$33 in modern currency. Now 60 years on it is more likely to cost nearer to \$1000 for professional top-grade tables equipped with all the modern features.



A good news story for the Club comes from coach Tony Ferro. His pupils the Woodley boys Lincoln, Brendan and Tyson have been playing in the Smash Hit grade representing our club. They won the first week comfortably then won the second week 9-0 Looking good boys.
