Recent Club History: - continuing from last month.

The Charles Sturt Council produced a list of the things that needed to be done to bring the building up to an agreed level of acceptance.

- These were:
1. Emergency Lighting
 2. Fire Hose Reel installation
 3. Southern wall to be fire rated
 4. Front door to open outwards

The Active Club grant application was accompanied by a letter of approval from the Council, and it was approved in 2006/07 and with help from Clive Sim plans were made and work started.

The biggest and most obvious job was the removal of the wall that had the old steel windows that were opened in the Summer. This was replaced by a new wall containing fire rated panels. The hose reel and water pipe work installation and emergency lighting were carried out without much disruption to the normal activities. The front door was replaced and hung so that it opened outwards. During this time Chris Leonard was in charge and steered the club through the crisis. The drama of those days is left to the history records.

We have had a complaint about the state of the clubrooms on Monday mornings when the ARPA group arrive and spend 30mins clearing the mess from Sunday night and washing up the dirty crockery.
